Transtoll Awarded Technical Advisory Contract for Sea-to-Sky

The Sea to Sky Highway Investment Limited Partnership has awarded Transtoll a contract to provide professional technical advisory services with regards to the Sea to Sky's traffic counting technology with special emphasis on overall system and counting accuracy.

Highway 99 is the Sea to Sky Highway, which winds through five distinct biogeoclimatic zones in the Vancouver Coast and Mountains region of BC, from coastal rain forest at Horseshoe Bay, through Squamish, Garibaldi Provincial Park, and the Resort Municipality of Whistler.

The work will be undertaken in stages and the first stage underway involves the following tasks;

- ▶ Review of the contract metrics and accuracy requirements;
- ▶ Technical review of the deployed traffic counting hardware technology;
- ▶ Site review of the hardware installation; and
- ▶ Report outlining initial findings and recommended actions.
